#### About the Aboriginal Housing Office

#### Who we are:

The Aboriginal Housing Office (AHO) is a statutory body established under the <u>Aboriginal Housing Act 1998 (NSW)</u> to ensure that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people have access to affordable, quality housing.

The AHO is governed by an all-Aboriginal Board, which provides advice to the Minister for Housing in NSW. In addition, the AHO manages and coordinates an annual capital works program, along with developing and implementing financial and resourcing strategies.

It is the AHO's Vision to ensure every Aboriginal person in NSW has equal access to, and choice in, affordable housing. The AHO achieves this vision by ensuring they continue to provide support to a sustainable housing sector through accessible, culturally appropriate and affordable housing solutions for the Aboriginal people of NSW.

In line with this Vision, the AHO is pleased to offer this funding grant opportunity to the Aboriginal housing sector of New South Wales.

#### Energy Efficiency Funding Program Overview

The AHO received funding in January 2024 through the Social Housing Energy Performance Initiative (SHEPI) to deliver an overarching co-funded Energy Efficiency Program worth \$12 million. A total of \$6 million has been approved for co-contribution funds to extend the Aboriginal Community Housing Provider (ACHP) Energy Efficiency Program.

The AHO will allocate \$4.5m of this funding to Aboriginal Community Housing Providers (ACHPs) through Round 3 of the Energy Efficiency Grant Funding Program. The Energy Efficiency Grant applications may fund up to a maximum of \$250,000 per Provider, to ease the cost-of-living pressures, whilst improving living conditions with improved heating and cooling options.

The Energy Efficiency Program may consist of but not limited to:

- Supply and install new Solar Panel PV systems;
- Supply and install solar hot water systems and heat pumps; and
- Supply and install air-conditioning split systems and ceiling fans.

The AHO has delivered similar projects for AHO housing / tenants with achieved benefits including improved living conditions and the reduction in the cost-of-living pressure due to Solar PV installation and other thermal programs. The AHO sees a clear gap with tenants living in Aboriginal Community owned homes who may have missed out on these improved living conditions due to the limited funding opportunities. This funding is looking to partly address this gap.

'Community owned' being Assets owned by Aboriginal Housing Providers including Local Aboriginal Land Councils (LALC's), Aboriginal Corporations (AC's) and Aboriginal Community Housing Providers (ACHP's).

'Providers' means NRSCH or NSWLS registered Aboriginal Community Housing Providers (ACHPs), AHO registered Aboriginal Community Housing Organisations (ACHOs) or Aboriginal Organisations who are not yet registered (but will need to apply and be approved for transitional registration with the AHO for the duration of the program).

#### Objectives for the Energy Efficiency Funding Program

The objectives for this funding program is outlined below:

- To identify a suite of eligible properties that will benefit from the upgrade of energy related assets including solar upgrades and temperature control upgrades (air conditioning) with delivery to be managed by the relevant Providers
- To increase the value of Provider properties and reduce ongoing maintenance requirements related to aged or unsuitable heating and cooling options
- To reduce the operating costs of Provider properties by completing a works program that aims to reduce electricity costs through the implementation of solar power options.
- To increase environmentally sustainable solutions in Provider properties by delivering a works program that considers a reduction of costs of living for heating and cooling (implementation of solar).
- Spread funding across suitable Providers with a maximum allocation per application capped at \$250k
- To manage a fair, transparent and auditable process in the identification of suitable properties and the allocation of funding.

#### Eligibility Criteria

Assets must meet the eligibility criteria and the project criteria for expenditure to be considered eligible under the funding program, including:

- Respondents must be a NRSCH or NSWLS registered Aboriginal Community Housing Provider (ACHP), an AHO registered Aboriginal Community Housing Organisation (ACHO), or Aboriginal Organisations who are not yet registered but will apply and be approved for transitional registration with the AHO for the duration of the program.
- Assets must be Community owned.
- Property must be in New South Wales.
- A list of affected properties / assets will need to be submitted through the SmartyGrants process to be considered
- Provide sufficient details to meet program requirements through the SmartyGrants process to assist to determine eligibility.


