

# Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

## How do I know if my organisation is eligible to apply?

Your organisation must either be:

- Registered under the National Regulatory System for Community Housing (NRSCH) or New South Wales Local Scheme (NSWLS); or
- Currently in process of undertaking registration; or
- Is scheduled to undertake registration; and
- Is located in New South Wales

## How much can I apply for?

Aboriginal Community Housing Provider's (ACHP's) who are successful will be eligible for a maximum funding amount of \$100,000.

## How long will the initiative run for?

The initiative will run for 12 months.

## How do I submit my application?

The Sector Development team will notify all known ACHPs via email about the grant.

ACHP's can apply via SmartyGrants. The Grant Administration System will explain the application process and potential funding opportunities.

## How long will the Grant Application be open for?

The Grant Application is open for four (5) weeks. The Grant Application opens on 31 March 2025 and closes at 5pm on 2 May 2025.

## When will I know the outcome?

Successful applicants are expected to be notified after 23 June 2025.

**Will I be required to sign a Funding Agreement if successful?**

Yes, all successful applicants will be required to sign a Funding Agreement for the agreed activities before payments are released.

A Funding Agreement template outlining the terms of Agreement is attached to the Grant Application for your information, refer to ***Attachment 1 – AHO Funding Agreement (Short Form) – Sector Capability Grant Program - DRAFT.***

**When will I be required to report to the AHO?**

Yes. The Funding Agreement requires your organisation will be required to report to the AHO:

- Progress reports on achievements of milestones for the funded activities; and
- a final report, including an acquittal component providing receipts for the expenditure of the Funding within one month after the end date, or when the activity has been finalised.

The reporting requirements are outlined in the Funding Agreement.
